The meeting began at 1:15 P.M with the chair initiating a discussion of the issues surrounding the previous committee minutes. The discussion promptly moved from there to a review of the Vision statement, objective statements, and related issues pertaining to clinicians and electronic health records.

Some of the addendums to the document included: deleting the use of the term EMR (electronic medical records) and using the more general term electronic health records (EHR), discussing the needs for the sharing of e-prescription data, and the need for analysis of programs in place including DOQ-IT. Dr Schiff mentioned that it may be helpful to obtain data from the success of DOQ-IT before it is fully funded. Dr Brull was concerned that if we waited too long- it might not get support for the next few years.
