Applicant must —

- 1. Complete all spaces pertaining to the applicant (including high school).
- 2. Complete additional education section if eligibility is to be based upon college education or pest control course work rather than experience.
- 3. Complete the experience in pest control section providing dates of employment, name and address of employer and the name of the technician who provided the supervision.
- 4. Complete percentage section indicating your field(s) of experience.
- 5. Check the examinations you wish to take.
- 6. Answer the question regarding violations, revocations, etc.
- 7. Complete the child support statement.
- 8. Select/list three examination dates and locations from the examination schedule in order of preference.
- 9. Print your name on the back of a current two inch by two inch color head and shoulders photograph on photographic paper (Xerox or regular paper copies are <u>NOT</u> acceptable) and attach where indicated.
- 10. Sign the application.
- 11. Have your supervisor sign the application, if eligibility is based upon your pest control experience. Attach a college transcript (or approved pest control course completion certificate) to the application if eligibility is based upon education.
- 12. Attach a **\$75** check or money order, if applicable, [**\$50 reduced fee if adding subcategories not previously examined to update an existing certification**] payable to the Illinois Department of Public Health.

If you have done all of the above, submit the application and your check or money order <u>at least 15 days</u> prior to the date of the first examination date listed to -
