

## Influenza & Pneumonia Mortality Surveillance

- **Data from CDC 122 Cities Morbidity and Mortality Reporting System**
- All age groups represented
- No pediatric influenza/ pneumonia deaths have been reported this season.

### **Laboratory Surveillance**

- Respiratory illness in military recruits at NRTC Great Lakes was reported at expected levels this week

#### **National Influenza Surveillance**

Twenty-one states reported sporadic activity, and 29 states reported no activity.

Sporadic: Small numbers of laboratory confirmed influenza cases or a single laboratory confirmed influenza in a single region of the state.

Local: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in a single region of the state.

\*This map indicates geographic spread and does not measure the severity of influenza activity.

Regional: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in at least two but less than half the regions of the state.

Widespread: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI cases and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in at least half the regions in the state.
