


### Influenza & Pneumonia Mortality Surveillance

- Data from CDC 122 Cities **Morbidity and Mortality Reporting System**
- All age groups represented
- No pediatric influenza/ pneumonia deaths have been reported this season.

### **Laboratory Surveillance**

- Respiratory illness in military recruits at NRTC Great Lakes was reported at expected levels this week
- Two positive specimens have been reported by the state laboratory

Three states reported regional activity, 10 states reported local activity, 30 states reported sporadic activity, and 6states reported no activity.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> No activity: No laboratory confirmed cases of influenza and no reported increase in cases of influenza like illness (ILI). Sporadic: Small numbers of laboratory confirmed influenza cases or a single laboratory confirmed influenza in a single region of the state. Local: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in a single region of the state. Regional: Outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in at least two but less than half the regions of the state.

Influenza like Illness" is defined as fever ≥ 100°F and cough and/or sore throat.

<sup>\*</sup> ILI data excluding the City of Chicago
