

## Role of the Public Health System to Implement SHIP

- 1. The Illinois Department of Public Health may be the coordinator and convener for SHIP implementation.
- 2. The larger system should be assigned to co-lead implementation.
- 3. We should work for long range and 'low-hanging fruit' to align statewide, regional and local efforts with the SHIP, e.g. Local I-PLANs should review the SHIP; IPHA's Annual Conference is aligned with the SHIP.
