Role of the
public health
system

- Consider whether a strategy is an activity that the public health system could undertake (e.g. monitoring)

Criteria

- Consider whether the strategy meets other key criteria for decision making

Select
Strategy

- Provide justification for selected strategy

Role of the Public Health System to Implement SHIP

1. The Illinois Department of Public Health may be the coordinator and convener for SHIP implementation.
2. The larger system should be assigned to co-lead implementation.
3. We should work for long range and 'low-hanging fruit' to align statewide, regional and local efforts with the SHIP, e.g. Local I-PLANs should review the SHIP; IPHA's Annual Conference is aligned with the SHIP.

Proposed Criteria

Role of the Public Health System

SDOH

- How does a proposed strategy address social / ecological factors?

Access

- How does a proposed strategy address access to care?

MCH

- How does a proposed strategy promote maternal and child health?

Urgency

- Is there a crisis?
- Are there efforts to build on?

Impact

- How many individuals does this reach?
- How is disparity addressed?

Evidence-Based

- Has this strategy been used before with measured success?

Resources

- What resources could be leveraged?
- Are new resources required?
